VARIETY	Phil 99-2641
PARENTAGE	Phil 83-129-3401 x Phil 8013
GROWTH HABIT	Good germinator, fast grower and is erect to recumbent
FLOWERING	very Sparse
LEAF CHARACTERISTICS	Broad drooping leaf blades. Leaf sheaths are green with heavy trichomes with no auricles. It is semi-self detrachasing.
STALK CHARACTERISTICS	Medium size (2.92cm), waxy, cylindrical, yellowish purple stalks with sparse corky cracks/patches and minimal aerial roots. It has slightly protruding big round eye-buds.
YIELD CHARACTERISTICS	High Sucrose (2.15 LKg/TC and above); High Tonnage (100 TC/Ha and above)
MILLABLE STALKS	2.23 stalks per stool at harvest
AVE. YIELD (6Locations)	2.04 LKg/TC; 116.95 TC/Ha
YIELD POTENTIAL	2.28 LKg/TC; 142.01 TC/Ha
REACTION TO DISEASES	It is resistant to smut and downy mildew, moderate to leaf scorch, and susceptible to yellow spot.
OTHERS	Phil 99-2641 performs best in SONEDCO Mill District in LKg/Ha significantly outyielding Phil 8013 and Phil 8477. It also obtained the highest average LKg/TC in 6 locations.
