

## **SAAD North Cotabato distributes Horse Dispersal Project to 5 FAs in Cotabato Province**

In a continuous assistance of the Special Area for Agricultural Development (SAAD) program under the Department of Agriculture, in sustaining farmers' necessities, Horse distribution to five FAs in Cotabato province has been conducted successfully on December 7, where a strict health protocol has been observed and followed.

A total of five Horses have been distributed to three Municipalities in Cotabato Province, namely: Municipality of President Roxas, Antipas and Arakan. Wherein, two FAs in President Roxas: The United Indigenous People of Lama-Lama (with 25 members) received one male horse and the Sallat Farmers Association (with 25 members) received one female horse. Also, the Datu Embangan Farmers Association (with 30 members) in Antipas has received one female horse only. And another two FAs in Arakan Cotabato: the Kinawayan Farmers Association (with 28 members) also received one female horse and the Kanit Farmers' Association (with 27 members) has also received one female horse.
