SRA's prime social responsibility is the implementation of programs for the socio-economic benefits of small farmers and workers of the sugarcane industry.

The SRA supports the welfare of the sugarcane farmers and workers in the country through the various outreach and capability-building programs such as trainings on best practices in sugarcane farming, technical trainings on fertilizer usage and application, advisory services, farm visits, etc.

SRA's policy for the mandatory collection of liens through the sugar quedan aims to fund the socio-economic needs of the sugarcane industry's dependents managed by the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) and implemented through the Sugar Amelioration Program (SAP) in partnership with the Sugar Industry Foundation, Inc. (SIFI) and the Planters Associations.
