

SUBJECT : **DEFERMENT OF PROCESSING OF APPLICATION FOR THE RECLASSIFICATION OF IMPORTED "C" OR RESERVED SUGAR TO "B" OR DOMESTIC SUGAR UNDER SUGAR ORDER NO. 3, SERIES OF 2021-2022, RE: SUGAR IMPORT PROGRAM FOR CROP YEAR 2021-2022**

In compliance with and to give effect to Memorandum Circular No. 1, Series of 2022, dated 30 June 2022, issued by the Office of the President, and in order to ensure the unhampered delivery of government service, **ATTY. IGNACIO S. SANTILLANA**, Deputy Administrator II, RD&E has been designated as Officer-in-Charge, Office of the Administrator.

By virtue of the above authority, all concerned industrial users of refined sugar under Sugar Order No. 3, Series of 2021-2022, or the Sugar Import Program for Crop Year 2021-2022, are hereby advised that all applications for the reclassification of imported "C" or reserve sugar to "B" or domestic sugar that have been approved by the previous SRA Sugar Board, by 30 June 2022, but which sugar are either (a) still under the custody of the Bureau of Customs (BoC); (b) not yet actually stored in SRA-registered warehouse; or (c) yet to arrive at the Philippine port territory are held in abeyance until the SRA Administrator and the Sugar Board Members shall have been duly appointed or constituted, and shall have acted on said applications.

Applications for reclassification filed after June 30, 2022 shall likewise be put on hold.

The SRA, on the other hand, shall continue to accept and process the applications for Clearance for Release of Imported Sugar under Sugar Order No. 3, Series of 2021-2022, through the office of Deputy Administrator II for Regulation, Atty. Guillermo C. Tejida III, by virtue of Administrative Order No. 1-A, Series of 2020, dated 13 July 2020.
