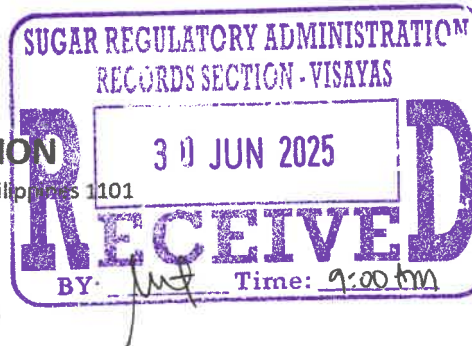
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SUPPLEMENTAL/BID BULLETIN NO. 1 **Supply and Delivery of Four (4) units Drone** **Bid Reference No. 2025-SIDA-08**

With reference to the Bidding Documents for the Supply and Delivery of Four (4) units Drone, posted at the PhilGEPS and SRA websites, this Supplemental/Bid Bulletin is being issued after having conferred with the Technical Working Group and the Provisional Member/End-user Representative, to clarify, amend, and modify some items in the provisions of the Bidding Documents, in response to the recommendations raised by prospective bidders, as follows:

ITB Clause 5.3 To consider the submission of ANY AGRICULTURAL MACHINERY for the Single Largest Completed Contract. <i>Reason: The drone specifically used for agricultural purposes is a new technology, and is gradually being accepted in modern farming.</i> <i>Although other agencies have similar procurement, the ABC and quantity differ, which may result in insufficient SLCC.</i>	Denied. The end-user will retain the stated requirement to ensure that the bidder is a direct supplier of the units.
	Other Request:		To include the Dealership Certificate specific for the procurement issued by the manufacturer/distributor as an additional requirement. <i>Reason: The dealership certificate ensures the procuring entity the</i>	Bidders may submit a Dealership Certificate, but it will not be required by the end-user.



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

Completed within five (5) years prior to the deadline for the submission and receipt of bids	ITB Clause 5.3 To allow the submission of an SLCC alongside another agricultural machine that performs the same spraying application or serves a similar agricultural function. <i>Reason: Most government agencies and individuals are not purchasing drones equipped with spraying capabilities. Instead majority of the drones being acquired are primarily intended for land surveying and mapping purposes. This mainly due to the high cost of spraying drones and the requirement for a licensed pilot to operate them.</i>	Denied. The end-user will retain the stated requirement to ensure that the bidder is a direct supplier of the units.

Technical Specifications	Item F.4 Pilot training, pilot license, and drone registration with CAAP	Item F.4 To allow Pilot training and drone registration with CAAP only. <i>Reason: Obtaining a pilot license is similar to acquiring a driver's license. Applicants must undergo both a written examination and a practical field test. The outcome of these exams is beyond the supplier/bidder's control, as it depends entirely on the applicant's performance.</i>	Denied. The end-user prefers to retain the requirement in order for the agency to avoid any issues with acquiring licenses for the pilots.

The drones are intended to be used for the application of insecticides against Red-Striped Soft

				Scale Insects, as such, it is preferred by the end-user to have the units delivered as soon as possible.
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The Supplemental/Bid Bulletin No. 1 shall form part of the Bidding Documents. Any provisions in the Bidding Documents inconsistent herewith is hereby amended, modified and superseded accordingly.
