

SRA Moderates Meeting Between Mead Johnson and PASRI

A meeting between Mead Johnson and Philippine Association of Sugar Refineries Inc. (PASRI) was held and moderated by the Sugar Regulatory Administration, headed by Administrator Hermenegildo Serafica and Board Member Roland Beltran on May 10, 2018.

Mead Johnson sought the help of SRA after experiencing difficulty with the status of their request for the importation of premium refined white sugar in strippable bags.

Companies like Mead Johnson import sugar that is not locally grown as an ingredient in their products.

Before concluding, PASRI allowed their importation but only until a certain period especially after identifying a local sugar mill, Don Pedro, as a potential supplier of the particular sugar.

Don Pedro promised to invest in the production of the said sugar with continued negotiations with Mead Johnson who promised to help them shoulder the finances.
